The regular meeting of the Bennett City Council was called to order by Mayor Sutton at 7:00 pm.

Council members present on roll call: Boedeker, Giebelstein, Schneekloth, Ehlers. Bentrrott was absent.

M/S, Giebelstein, Schneekloth to approve Consent agenda including minutes, financial report & bills.

V&K, Emily Linebaugh: There has been discussion on land purchase & she advised Council/Mayor to not discuss this with the public and go into Closed Session if needed. There may need to be changes made to the shape of the project. Working with Financial Advisor for possible rate increase. Emily presented mechanical plant option as a possibility. City would not qualify for a USDA grant because of the City income from 2010 census. We are in the "loan only" category with them.

Fire department: 1 call and 1 controlled burn.

Ambulance report: 12 calls. Peace Church & Bennett School will be using the ambulance building during the Holiday Walk.

Sheriff's Report : 7 calls.
