The regular meeting of the Bennett City Council was called to order by Mayor Sutton at 7:05 PM.

Council members present on roll call: Boedeker, Bentrott, Giebelstein, Schneekloth, Eicher.

M/S, Giebelstein, Boedeker to approve Consent agenda including minutes, financial report & bills.

Citizens: Pam Hartwig was present to discuss 135th Celebration in August 2019. Looking at 2 bands, 1 for Friday evening and another for Saturday evening. Possibility of an all school reunion on that Friday evening also. Many ideas are in the works and next meeting will be 2/10 @ 2:30 PM – Ambulance building-all are welcome to join. Will also need to look more into hiring security. City will cover the cost of extra insurance for event.

Library: Circulation was 240 and 2 programs in January.

Fire department: 2 calls.

Ambulance report: 11 calls.

Administration report : FY20 budget update. Tax rate will be set at 14.16394%

Sheriff's Report : 14 calls.

Superintendent: Water main break at the school.

Parks: Purchasing new equipment and looking into grants.

New Business:

1. New sewer/water rates will be presented for new Ordinance starting July 1, 2019. Minimum sewer rate will go from \$17.20 to \$20.00/monthly and water minimum will go from \$10.00 to \$15.00. Will also put a debt fee into place beginning July 1, 2019 - \$15 for July-March, going up to \$20 for April-June, going up to \$25 for July-September and ending the year at \$30.00 for October-December.

3. Public hearing is set for March 4, 2019 at 6:45 PM to present FY2020 budget report.
